



395 Express Lanes Project-Eads Street Construction Traffic Impacts

The purpose of this building circular is to inform all Pentagon building occupants of the Virginia Department of Transportation's (VDOT) 395 Express Lanes Project-Eads Street construction, affecting the Pentagon Reservation.

On or about Thursday, June 21, 2018 and continuing through the Fall of 2018, VDOT will begin the phases for set up and construction of work zones on Eads Street by the Pentagon Reservation that will impact traffic. Construction work will include the demolition and reconfiguration of existing islands and medians, pavements and sidewalks, and the installation of traffic signals. The Eads Street construction supports the 395 Express Lane project, which will extend the 395 Express Lanes for eight miles north from Turkeycock Run near Edsall Road to the vicinity of Eads Street in Arlington. The two existing High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes will be converted to three reversible express lanes.

The following will go into effect on or about the listed dates:

- **On or about Thursday, June 21, 2018:**
 - Phase 1 of the construction will begin along Eads Street to reconfigure medians, demolish islands and install permanent pavement. It is expected that Phase 1 will take approximately four weeks, or until Monday, July 23, 2018 (subject to weather conditions).
- **Nightly and Weekend closures of Eads Street:**
 - Eads Street, between South Rotary Road and Army Navy Drive, will be closed on weeknights, Monday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m. and weekends from Friday at 8 p.m through Monday at 4 a.m. I-395 HOV ramp access will also be closed during the times specified above. Detours with signage will be set out via Fern Street (please see attachment). Eads Street southbound between North Rotary Road and South Rotary Road will also be restricted as part of the detour plan.
